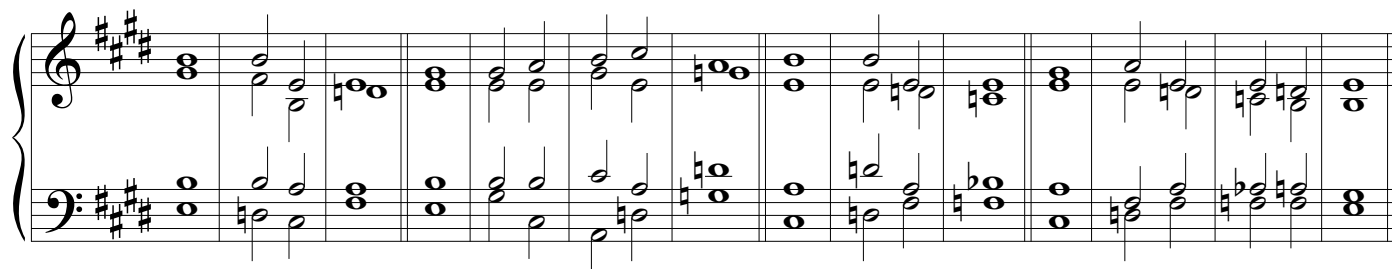


## Psalm 14
